

Fall 2017 Olympic View Elementary After-School Enrichment Classes

Priority deadline for registration forms is Monday, September 18th. Open enrollment will be available through Friday, September 22nd, as space is available. After September 22nd, enrollment closes and students can no longer enroll in a Fall class. Please note that we will be waiting to collect payment until after class confirmations are sent home. Your student will bring home a form indicating which class they are assigned to, whether or not a scholarship was granted and what your balance due is.

Please note: in order to be considered for a scholarship you must return your form by the September 18th deadline.

Please keep in mind the following information:

1. Classes run for 8 weeks on Thursdays, October 5th - November 30th (No class November 23rd).
2. Classes begin at 2:40pm and end promptly at 3:40pm. Please be ON TIME to pick up your student(s).
3. Priority deadline is September 18th. Submit your form online, to your teacher or drop it off in the office.
4. Open Enrollment is available until September 22nd.
5. Payments are due after class confirmations are received but no later than October 4th and can be turned in via check made out to: OVPTA, or online at ovpta.org. Please write the student's name on the check or indicate their name when making a payment online.
6. Transportation is not formally provided by the PTA or the school.
7. Students will go to the cafeteria at 2:25pm, check in and receive a small snack. Instructors will pick up students from the cafeteria and then begin class.

Scholarships: There are an extremely limited number of scholarships available for Fall Session. If you are requesting a scholarship, you must turn your form in on time to be considered (September 18th). Scholarships are selected through a lottery system and must be approved by school administration.

PIANO-KEYBOARD CLUB by Musical Minds

Kids will have the opportunity to learn to play their favorite songs and music on electric keyboards. The club is a combination of keyboard piano lessons and a music learning workshop, which uses a clever visual method to teach the basics of music reading and piano playing. Magic is a great strategy game that combines elements of the game of chess and poker in which you bring your own pieces to play. This program will be geared for both new and experienced MTG players. Over the course of the session each participant will be provided a Planeswalker deck and additional booster packs. Students are allowed to play either with the provided deck or any other deck they bring from home.

Outdoor Wilderness will be a blast learning through adventure! Join us as we turn Olympic View's playground into our own wilderness. We'll play games, spending time enjoying the outdoors, and while we are at it we'll learn outdoor living skills, like making our own shelters, navigating around our own OV wilderness using orienteering skills, and lots and lots of team building activities. All our activities will be a combination of energetic games, team activities, leadership opportunities, and self-reliance. Students will play theater games that will help them learn the basics of theater and acting while increasing their listening skills, confidence, concentration skills and ability to work together. We will choose different children's stories and lift them off the page using our bodies and imaginations. Students who take this class find a new motivation for reading while playing and having fun.

Ceramics

Roll up your sleeves, let your imagination soar, and let's play with clay! You will learn a variety of hand building techniques as you make fun, creative projects that will last a lifetime. Projects will be painted with an assortment of bright colors to choose from and then fired in a kiln creating a finished look to your piece. Our last project will be painted using a cold finish, which is craft paint and can be taken home that same day. We will make everything; from animals and picture frames, to monsters and seasonal/holiday projects, and so much more! I'm always striving to come up with new projects so classes will always be new and exciting. So let's have some fun! I hope to see you there! Just a little reminder...we get a little dirty in here but everything is washable.

BEGINNER/INTERMEDIATE (split level class): Do you play games and wonder how they are created? Would you like to build your own computer programs? Come learn how at the Coding with Kids Academy! In this fun after-school class, BEGINNERS will be introduced to the core concepts of computer programming, including loops, conditionals and variables. INTERMEDIATE students will move onto more advanced concepts, such as nested conditionals and functions with parameters. Using the Scratch development environment, you will learn how to create a variety of programs, from simple animations to multi-level games. With new projects each session, you will be able to express your creativity and advance as a coder!

Eagle Way ART

Students will experience "The Eagle Way" by creating art for themselves, each other, and the school in this fun and friendly class. We will focus on building up affirmations and virtues using acrylic paint on rock, canvas, and the north staircase!

Henna- Basic Skills

Each class will be tailored to individual kids ability to draw as assessed during the first class. The first class will include a powerpoint and short video clips to build the student knowledge base regarding where raw materials comes from. That is, information about henna plant and processing of the henna leaves. Also, in the first class, we will get to learn a little about the regions where henna tattoos are an integral part of celebrations in their culture. Each student will have small activity booklets to guide and support their developing skills through assisted practice. One student in each class will be selected to get a henna tattoo done by the instructor. The last class will showcase the skills of students in henna tattoo art by drawing henna tattoos on hands and / or arms and feet of their fellow artists.
